
Passover Haggadah

Introduction

We have gathered here tonight to remember Yahweh's Passover. To be thankful for His provision, providing an atoning sacrifice worthy to cover all our sins. We see a picture of our redemption in the first Passover. When by faith, the Israelites applied the blood of a lamb to their doorpost, allowing them to be passed over from death to life. Showing the plan of redemption from eternal death is only received if the blood of the *lamb* has been applied to our lives.

The Cup of Sanctification

Volunteer:

For you are a holy people to Yahweh, and Yahweh has chosen you to be a people for His own possession out of all the peoples who are on the face of the earth. Deuteronomy 14:2

For when you were slaves of sin, you were free in regard to righteousness. Therefore, what benefit were you then deriving from things of which you are now ashamed? For the outcome of those things is death. But now having been freed from sin and enslaved to Yahweh, you derive your benefit, resulting in sanctification, and the outcome eternal life. For the wages of sin is death, but the free gift of Yahweh is eternal life in Yeshua. Romans 6:20-23

But we should always give thanks to Yahweh for you, brethren beloved by Yahweh, because Yahweh has chosen you from the beginning for salvation through sanctification by the Spirit and faith in the truth. 2Thessalonians 2: 13

Leader:

Let us líft up our cups, as we thank Yahweh for bringing us out of the world, to be His own possession!

This Passover feast leads us into the next Feast of Yahweh, the Feast of Unleavened Bread. Leaven is symbolic of sin. After receiving the blood of Yeshua as an atonement for our sins, we are to strive to live an unleavened life by carefully removing sin from our life and walking as the Messiah walked. These things are to be done at the proper time and season. Your children may ask: "Why do we have to eat this unleavened bread?"

1st Child's portion to read:

Now this day will be a memorial to you, and you shall celebrate it as a feast to Yahweh; throughout your generations you are to celebrate it as a permanent ordinance. Seven days you shall eat unleavened bread, but on the first day you shall remove leaven from your houses; for whoever eats anything leavened from the first day until the seventh day, that person shall be cut off from Israel. Exodus 12: 14-15

2nd Child portion to read:

Clean out the old leaven so that you may be a new lump, just as you are in fact unleavened. For Yeshua our Passover has been sacrificed. There for let us celebrate the feast, not with old *leaven, not with the leaven of malice and wickedness, but with the unleavened bread of sincerity and truth. 1Corinthians 5:7-8*

Leader:

We eat this bread, and remember this feast day, because it is the day that we were freed from the household of sin. It is the day that we, through the perfect Passover Lamb, received the ability to become unleavened. Having had our sins washed away, we become as this unleavened bread, in the eyes of Yahweh. Yeshua uses this bread as a symbol of himself. Yeshua is the sinless unleavened bread of life that takes away the sin of the world.

The leader takes the bread, breaks it, and places it in a unity bag while placing the Afikomen in a separate bag. This portion of unleavened bread will be hidden away, only to return very soon! This date that we are all sitting here is not just a date that we all agreed would be a nice night to get together for a dinner. This date was established by Yahweh. So that we would always remember what He did for us.

These are the appointed times of Yahweh, holy convocations which you shall proclaim at the times appointed for them. In the first month, on the fourteenth day of the month at twilight is Yahweh's Passover. On the fifteenth day of the same month there is a feast of unleavened bread to Yahweh; for seven days you shall eat unleavened bread. Leviticus 23:4-6

Now, let the sons of Israel observe the Passover at its appointed time. On the fourteenth day of this month, at twilight, you shall observe it at its appointed time; you shall observe it according to all its statutes and according to all its ordinances. Numbers 9: 2-3

The Cup of Judgement: 2nd

Volunteer:

If, then you act with hostility against Me and are unwilling to obey Me, I will increase the plague on you seven times according to your sins. Leviticus 26: 21

If you are not careful to observe all the words of this law which are written in this book, to fear this honored and awesome name, Yahweh your God, then Yahweh will bring extraordinary plagues on you and your descendants, even severe and lasting plagues, and miserable and chronic sickness. He will bring back on you all the diseases of Egypt of which you were afraid, and they will cling to you. Also, every sickness and every plague which, not written in the book of this law, Yahweh will bring on you until you are destroyed. Deuteronomy 28: 58-61 I testify to everyone who hears the words of the prophecy of this book: if anyone adds to them, Yahweh will add to him the plagues which are written in this book, and if anyone takes away from the words of the book of this prophecy, Yahweh will take away his part from the tree of life and from the holy city, which are written in this book. Revelations 22:18-19

Leader:

Now it shall be, if you diligently obey Yahweh your God, being careful to do all His commandments which I command you today, Yahweh will set you high above all the nations of the earth. All these blessings will come upon you and overtake you if you obey Yahweh your God. Deuteronomy 28: 1

Let us lift up our cup, and be thankful for Yahweh's promise of blessings, may we not act hostile towards Him. Let us carefully obey Him and walk in His ways!

Allow children to find Afikomen:



Leader:

Yeshua said it was His earnest desire to eat the Passover with His disciples before He was to suffer. We are gathered here to remember that night, and what it meant to the whole world. By observing these symbols of a lamb, wine, and unleavened bread it paints a picture of the price that was paid for our sins.

While they were eating, Yeshua took some bread, and after blessing it, He broke it and

gave it to the disciples and said take, eat; this is my body. Mathew 26: 26

Prayer: Father, thank you for this bread of life you so graciously gave us.

And when He had taken a cup and given thanks, He gave it to them saying drink from it, all of you, for this is my blood of the covenant, which is poured out for many for forgiveness of sins. But I say to you, I will not drink of this fruit of the vine from now on until that day when I drink it new with you in My Fathers Kingdom. Mathew 26: 27

Prayer: Father, thank you for this New Covenant in Messiah Yeshua's blood. Thank you for the blood that atones for sin once and for all.

Therefore, whoever eats the bread or drinks the cup of Yeshua in an unworthy manner, shall be guilty of the body and the blood of Yeshua. But a

man must examine himself, and in so doing he is to eat of the bread and drink of the cup. For he who eats and drinks, eats and drinks judgment to himself if he does not judge the body rightly. 1 Corinthians 11: 27-29

The Cup of Redemption 3rd

Volunteer:

Behold, days are coming declares Yahweh, when I will make a New Covenant with the house of Israel and with the house of Judah, not like the covenant which I made with their fathers in the day I took them by the hand to bring them out of the land of Egypt, My covenant which they broke, although I was a husband to them, declares Yahweh. But this is the covenant which I will make with the house of Israel after those days, declares Yahweh, I will put My Law within them and on their heart I will write it; and I will be their God, and they shall be My People. Jeremiah 31:31 As for Me, this is My covenant with them, say Yahweh: My Spirit which is upon you, and My words which I have put in your mouth shall not depart from your mouth, nor from the mouth of your offspring, nor from the mouth of your offspring's offspring, say Yahweh, from now and forever. Isaiah59: 21

Blessed be Yahweh, Father of our Messiah Yeshua, who has blessed us with every spiritual blessing in the heavenly places in Yeshua. Just as He chose us in Him before the foundation of the world, that we would be holy and blameless before Him. The Cup of Praise 4th

Volunteer:

O, come, let us sing for joy to Yahweh, let us shout joyfully to the Rock of our Salvation. Let us come before His presence with thanksgiving, let us shout joyfully to Him with Psalms. For Yahweh is a great God and a great King above all gods. Psalms 95:1-3

But when this perishable will have put on imperishable, and this mortal will have put on immortality, then will come about the saying that is written, DEATH IS SWALLOWED UP IN VICTORY. O DEATH, WHERE IS YOUR VICTORY? O DEATH, WHERE IS YOUR STING? The sting of death is sin, and the power of sin is the law; but thanks be to Yahweh who gives us the victory through Yeshua! ICorinthians 15 54-57

Leader:
